

# **Historical Milestones**

1998 – Google was incorporated as a privately held company

The company's mission statement: "To organize the world's information and make it universally accessible and useful."

Google made the world a much smaller place

International trade became readily available for everyone; not just large corporations

### **Historical Milestones**

#### November 2001 – China Admitted to the WTO

# **Unintended Consequences**

November 29, 2001 – ERAI receives 1st nonconforming part complaint against a China based distributor

3A Century aka Gold Advanced aka JXJ

Part number: TCM3105DW

Description of the product nonconformance:

Parts arrived in Samsung tubes (ordered TI parts). Numerous mixed date codes arrived in a single tube. Solder splash present on part leads. There were 'wash marks' and smears on the upper surface of the chip.

Almost immediately China distributors began refurbishing and remarking parts to have consistent date and lot codes in order to pass used parts off as new.



# **Unintended Consequences**


Environmental initiatives (ROHS) help create the E-Waste phenomenon

Internet helps create a cloak of legitimacy for Chinese suppliers hiding behind professionally designed English websites on internet search engines and trading platforms

# **Other Milestones 2006-Present**

**2007:** Naval Air Systems Command (NAVAIR) asks the Bureau of Industry and Security's (BIS) Office of Technology Evaluation (OTE) to conduct a defense industrial base assessment of counterfeit electronics.

- SAE G-19 Committee is formed.
- U.S. and European customs launched "Operation Infrastructure" resulting in the seizure of over 360,000 counterfeit IC's that were destined for U.S and European Markets.

2008: Business Week Article "Dangerous Fakes" is released which increases counterfeit awareness.

2009: AS5553 gets released and becomes adopted by DOD.

- Counterfeit Electronics Survey initiated by the U.S. Department of Commerce Bureau of Industry, Office of Technology Evaluation.
- First Federal Indictment directly related to counterfeit IC's.

2010: Department of Commerce, BIS report released.

- Government Account Office (GAO) releases two studies related to counterfeit and pirated goods.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Federal Indictment directly related to counterfeit IC's.



# **Milestones Continued**

**2011:** Senators Levin and McCain announce a Senate Armed Services Committee investigation into counterfeit Electronic parts and the risk they pose to the Department of Defense (DOD) supply chain.

- ARP6178 Fraudulent/Counterfeit Electronic Parts; Tool for Risk Assessment of Distributors was published.
- Senate passage of the Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2012.
- President Obama signs 2012 NDAA which includes (Sec. 818) Detection and Avoidance of Counterfeit Electronic Parts.

**2012:** Final report is released from SASC: Inquiry Into Counterfeit Electronic Parts in the Department of Defense Supply Chain.

- Release of GAO study: Suspect counterfeit electronic parts can be found on internet purchasing platforms
- AS6081 Standard is published and released

2013: Industry waiting for clarification from SOD on Sec. 818 of NDAA.

# **Communicate Your Expectations**

- Quality driven Independents do exist and problems can be reduced or eliminated if you identify who they are, and clearly define your expectations.
- Accept the fact that counterfeiting has forever changed the market and adjust accordingly.
- Don't make quality assumptions based on a phone conversation, e-mail, website or part data showing availability on the internet.
- Establish reliable supply chain partners who meet your quality standards.
